**TO ALL THE OBC MEMBERS WORKING IN HYDERABAD CIRCLE**

Dear members,

The erstwhile eSBH OBC Employees' Welfare Association registered in the year 1996, since our Association clinched all benefits as per Government of India Guidelines. The name of the Association has been changed to SBI OBC Employees Welfare Association. I appeal to all OBC members working in State Bank of India in Hyderabad Circle, to join & strengthen the Association and to achieve further benefits from Government of India.

II. We have modified registered name of SBH OBC Welfare Association (established in the year 1996) to **SBI OBC Employees Welfare Association, Hyderabad Circle**.

III. We have formed and Registered (Regd No.744 of 2017) SBI OBC Employees Welfare Associations **FEDERATION**.

IV. We have Registered and established SBI OBC Welfare Associations in seven Circles (Hyderabad, Amaravati, Jaipur, Chandigarh, Lucknow, Patna & Mumbai). Shortly establishing in Chennai, Bangalore, Ahmadabad,

V. During the last 20 years of our struggle, we achieved, the following welfare measures and support of the Government of India and Department of Financial Services.

1. Conducting of half yearly meetings regularly - At Head Office (Circle), Zonal Offices (AO) & specially separated Regional Offices.

2. Providing Pre-Promotions Trainings: - i) to Sub staff to Clerical, ii) Clerical to Officer Cadre & iii) JMGS-I to MM-II

3. Conducting a day's workshop for Office Bearers to create awareness regarding of the welfare measures extended by Government of Indian and reservation policy.

4. Provided Check off Facility (monthly subscription deduction from salary & credit to Association Account)

5. Provided Office space at Head Office (Office Premises at eSBH)

6. Provided immunity of Office bearers (Protections of transfer to office bearers)

7. Liaison Officers: –

Chief Liaison Officer at Head Office - General Manager cadre, Liaison Officer in AO/ZO – Chief Manager ZOCC & Liaison Officer in RBO – Chief Manager (GB)

8. To ensure 27% reservation in recruitment for OBC category in all posts and services.

9. To Ensure candidates recruited on the basis of merit in an open competition on the same standards prescribed for the general candidates shall not be adjusted against the reserved quota for OBCs

10. To ensure proper carry forward unfilled reserved vacancies, due to non-availability of OBC candidates for a period of 3 years.

11. To launch special recruitment drive filling up the backlog vacancies for OBCs, wherever necessary.

12. Upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment shall be relaxed by 3 years in respect of OBC candidates.

13. A separate OBC Cell at Head Office, Liaison Officer preferably belongs to OBC Category will be posted to ensure implementation of the reservations and other welfare measures taken up by the Government for OBC employees.
